

# AutoCert+ Cancel and Cancel/Replace by Client Order ID User Manual

12 August 2022



Neither futures trading nor swaps trading are suitable for all investors, and each involves the risk of loss. ## **Getting Started**

The AutoCert+ tool is an automated testing tool for validating application functionality. It provides an easy-to-use web interface for using CME Group certification scenarios.

To facilitate the process of connecting a customer application to CME Globex, CME Group provides a dedicated certification environment to allow customers to test their systems before completing certification.

The following apply to each iLink test case:

- The book is clear at the beginning of each test.
- After the instrument is selected, the instrument is locked until the test is completed.
- If you submit an incorrect response to any question in a test case, you must repeat the test case from the beginning.
- For partial or complete fills, assume CME Group creates the appropriate orders in the book.

**Note:** If a test is not proceeding to the next step, selecting the Refresh button (**REFRESH**) below the test steps may resolve the issue.

The following procedures describe and illustrate the supplemental iLink 3 Order Entry test cases for customer firms that certified for <u>iLink 3</u> Order Entry for Futures & Options to use the optional <u>Cancel/Cancel-Replace by Client Order ID</u> Globex functionality by performing additional certification to support this new feature.

#### To access and navigate AutoCert+:

- 1. Log into the automated certification tool.
- 2. Review general AutoCert+ test suite navigation and general interview information.

Access the Cancel and Cancel / Replace by Client Order ID test suite.

Use the AutoCert+ testing configuration menu to select the following:

- Tester: Automatically selected based on the logged in user
- Company Name
- Market: Futures & Options
- Purpose: Order Entry iLink 3
- Application System: Select the system to test
- Test Suite: Cancel and Cancel / Replace by ClOrdID
- Sendercomp: Then select Assign

## Interview

The interview consists of a series of questions about your trading application. Based on your responses, certain tests are required and others are optional. You must complete the pre-certification interview before running the test cases.

#### **To complete the interview:**

Answer each question and click the" Complete" button when finished.

- How does your application register Administrative Information? (check all that apply)
- Will your system support Cancel Replace without OrderID-Tag 37?

If Yes is selected, Order Cancel-Replace (pre-registered / on-demand) is mandatory.

• Will your system support Order Cancel without OrderID-Tag37?

If Yes is selected, Order Cancel (pre-registered / on-demand) is mandatory.

## Order Cancel Replace without OrderID

The purpose of this test is to verify the client system can submit a <u>New - Day Limit Order</u> message, then send an <u>Order</u> <u>Cancel-Replace Request</u> message without providing an OrderID and receive and <u>Execution Report - Modify</u> message.

- 1. Select a SenderComp from the drop-down and select ASSIGN if an Instrument is not already assigned.
- 2. From the **Instrument(s)** drop-down, select the desired instrument if it is not already locked.
- 3. Select the **START TEST** button.

**Note**: DO NOT select the START TEST button once the test is in progress. If a test is not proceeding to the next step, selecting the Refresh button (REFRESH) below the test steps may resolve the issue.

### Pre-Registered or On-Demand Format

This test is used for both Pre-Registered and On-Demand formats. The below instructions show the On-Demand format.

To run a Order Cancel Replace without OrderID test:

- 1. Over an iLink connection submit a <u>Day Limit Order</u> Message [35=D | tag 40-OrderType=2 (Limit order) | tag 59-TimeInForce=0 (Day)].
- 2. Receive and Process the Execution Report New Order Message (35=8, 39=0).
- 3. Submit and Order Cancel / Replace Request without OrderID Message (35=G | tag 11-ClOrdID).
- 4. Receive and process an Execution Report Modify Message (35=8, 39=5).

## Order Cancel without OrderID

The purpose of this test is to verify the client system can submit a <u>New - Day Limit Order</u> message, then send an <u>Order Cancel</u> Request message without providing an OrderID and receive and Execution Report - Cancel message.

- 1. Select a **SenderComp** from the drop-down and select **ASSIGN** if an Instrument is not already assigned.
- 2. From the Instrument(s) drop-down, select the desired instrument if it is not already locked.
- 3. Select the **START TEST** button.

**Note**: DO NOT select the START TEST button once the test is in progress. If a test is not proceeding to the next step, selecting the Refresh button (**REFRESH**) below the test steps may resolve the issue.

### Pre-Registered or On-Demand Format

This test is used for both Pre-Registered and On-Demand formats. The below instructions show the Pre-Registered format.

To run a Order Cancel without OrderID test:

- Over an iLink connection submit a <u>New Day Limit Order</u> Message [35=D | tag 40-OrderType=2 (Limit order) | tag 59-TimeInForce=0 (Day) | tag 1505-PartyDetailsListReqID].
- 2. Receive and Process the Execution Report New Order Message (35=8, 39=0).
- 3. Submit and Order Cancel Request without OrderID Message (35=F | tag 11-ClOrdID).
- 4. Receive and process an Execution Report Cancel Message (35=8, 39=4).
